

## **Food for Thought**

All farmers and gardeners who have lovingly planted seeds and crops have to learn how to be patient, knowing that the seeds and crops they have planted won't come up straight away. They have to be patient as they await the fruits of their labour. In today's reading St James looks to the prophets as an example of patience as he speaks of their patience in waiting for the coming of the Lord. Mary was patient too – patiently trusting in God, even when she didn't understand. At the foot of the cross Mary waited patiently. Patience has never been an easy virtue to have because we usually want things to happen quickly! I'm sure that John the Baptist wanted things to happen quickly as he languished in prison for speaking the truth!
