Food for Thought

The first reading today is a lesson on basic wisdom. Everything in this world is limited and passing. Very often we focus on things that we think will make us happy. We live in an age when we are told we can buy happiness. We can be pressurised to live beyond our means. Credit cards, or electronic money can help us to make decisions that are unwise and sometimes costly! We don't need to 'buy' real joy - it comes from the closeness of God and from his presence in our lives.

The Word of the Lord today tells us about other "costs" that are sometimes high. In today's Gospel Jesus uses strong language, making it clear that to be a follower of His will be costly, but our reward, which would make any necessary sacrifice a small price to pay – is eternal life. It's not always easy being a follower of the Lord, but by following Him we can belong to the Kingdom of God, where we will know enough love, peace, and happiness, to make any 'costs' worthwhile. So those difficult words in today's Gospel, really have a simple message..... turn away from all that keeps us from the Lord and - love all that brings us closer to Him!
