### **Food for Thought**

If we want to hear God speaking to us in our big and noisy world, we sometimes need to find quiet time alone with Him. Today's first reading tells us how Elijah thought he would experience God in a strong heavy wind, or in an earthquake or fire. Instead He found God in a gentle breeze.....a tiny whispering sound. However, the Gospel today tells us how Peter and the disciples were able to hear Jesus' voice in the loudness of the storm. How reassuring amidst the raging storm to hear the words that Jesus spoke. "Courage...it is I, do not be afraid." For many people who are encountering a storm in their lives, these words bring comfort. There are times for all of us when our faith seems strong and we feel we can do anything but the fact remains that, when the storms hit and the doubts set in, we can feel that we are sinking beneath the waves. When that happens remember the Lord's words ... Courage....do not be afraid. Take time to listen for the 'tiny whispering sound' and the still small voice of calm that is always with us.
