What a difference between Jesus' response to Peter last week when He declared Peter to be the rock on which He would build His Church, to today when He calls Peter an obstacle to His mission! Peter couldn't understand that the Lord had to suffer. Today Jesus says to each Christian... " Anyone who wants to be a follower of mine, must take up his cross every day and follow me".
