Food for Thought

Today's Gospel starts with a straight question from Peter - how many times are we to forgive? It is an interesting question for us all, because forgiving those who have hurt us is not easy. Sometimes the bigger the hurt the more difficult it can be to forgive, but Jesus tells us very clearly in today's Gospel that we must forgive. Jesus tells us that forgiveness is the door that leads to reconciliation.... that leads us to peace. Sometimes the hurt is so painful that we can't manage to forgive by ourselves.....but there is no relationship..... no hurt so painful...... no heart so wounded that cannot be healed by the grace of God.
