The situation Jesus describes in today's Gospel is one that we're all familiar with. He tells a simple story of two imperfect sons to illustrate the way of God's kingdom. We have all met people who say they will do something and then we find that they have not – and those who initially may be against an idea or refuse a request, then have a change of heart and get on with it. The Word of the Lord reminds us today not to get too complacent. It challenges us to change - to grow - to make the right choices and not just pay lip service. The Church of St Mary of the Isle of Man

Pope Francis has granted cathedral status to the church of Saint Mary of the Isle based in Douglas in the Isle of Man. The announcement comes following Douglas being awarded city status as part of the late Queen Elizabeth's Platinum Jubilee celebrations in June 2022. The Church will be a co-cathedral for the Archdiocese of Liverpool alongside the Metropolitan Cathedral of Christ the King.

Archbishop Malcolm McMahon, said:

"It is with great joy that St Mary of the Isle has been granted cathedral status. The Isle of Man is a significant part of our archdiocese, it constitutes one third of its land mass and the island's Catholic community has increasing diversity with parishioners coming from many different parts of the world."
