### Food for thought

As we begin another Lent, today's Gospel reminds us that no matter how many Lents we have lived through, the call to 'Repent and believe the Good News' is as urgent now as it ever was, so that we can come to our celebration at Easter filled with a rainbow of light. There is something very special in the appearance of a rainbow against the dark rain clouds - a sign that the sun can play with the rain -drops and transform them into an arch of colour - it takes both sunshine and rain to make a rainbow. It's a bit like that in life – we need to experience dark times before we can appreciate that there is always light at the end of the tunnel and that good times will come again. We know the legend about the treasure that lies at the end of a rainbow - but perhaps a greater treasure and the real truth - is that when we see a rainbow, we remember God's love for humanity and His everlasting covenant with us. God gave Noah the rainbow as a reassuring sign of his goodness so that he could bring the people out of the flood to a new creation — Jesus brings us new life through the waters of our Baptism.
