Food Bank: The food bank is under extreme pressure to meet the increasing needs of families. Please be generous if you are able during this harvest time.

SVP - Collection In order to help families in need in our parish schools the SVP will hold three money collections between 27th November and 11th December. Money raised will be used to buy vouchers to be distributed by our three schools according to need as Christmas approaches.

SVP: There will be a weekly meeting of the older men in the parish for lunch and a chat at the Bull's Head at 1pm on Wednesdays for about 2 hours. All welcome.

Mass of Remembrance for those who have died over the last year will be on Wednesday 23rd November at 7pm in Holy Family.

Warm Places : This is already underway in many places across the diocese, and we hope to offer a few hours with tea and coffee and possibly simple food in St Ambrose Hall (Holy Family too once the hall is open). We need volunteers for this to happen. I propose Tuesday after the 9.15am Mass at St Ambrose until 11.30am but this is only possible with volunteers. Please let Fr Paul know if you are able to help so that a rota can be put together.

Barnabus Collection: This year the SVP are running a collection for clothing to be donated to Barnabus. This year this charity will greatly help more people than normal. Please bring clothing to either church over the next few weeks so that it can be delivered before the winter weather sets in.

Children's Liturgy: Both Masses on a Sunday are looking to restart this valuable service for our children as soon as is practically possible.

St Ambrose Barlow – We need 8 people ideally to run this on a rota basis so you would support once a month during school term times. There are parishioners who can help getting this up and running again and can provide practical support and material resources. If you would like to volunteer please email karenstansfield@live.co.uk so a meeting can be set up to take this forward. Alison Doctor will be in the church hall after Mass too if you would like to speak to her.

Holy Family – We have a few volunteers but need several more to be able to run a rota in a similar way to St Ambrose. If you would like to volunteer, please speak to either Fr Paul or to Liz in the parish office as soon as possible.

Please note that all volunteers must complete a DBS form with the Archdiocese to comply with safeguarding which is paramount in all parish activities. Thank you for your generosity.
