White Poppy: The wearing of a white poppy is a way of promoting remembrance for all people, soldiers and civilians, who have died in war and conflict around the world. It is a flower used as a symbol of peace and can be worn to complement, or as an alternative to, the red poppy for Remembrance Day.
