Holy Family Tea and Coffee after Mass: The tea and coffee morning is cancelled this weekend as the contractors will replace the flooring this week.

First Holy Communion 2024: Those who are in Y4 in the three parish schools should now have received a letter and an application form. For those children in Y4 in other local schools there are forms available at the back of both churches. Please return forms to church (or one of our schools) before the half term break.

Families of Parishes: There are currently 104 diocesan priests in our Archdiocese. The figure projected for 15 years time is 37. The Pastoral Plan produced by the Archdiocese after Synod 2020 presents a vision for the way forward. At the heart of this vision is a commitment to create within Deaneries 'Families of Parishes' which will work more closely together. At the back of church today there are copies of a document which spells out how this might work.

Food Bank: As winter approaches please give generously if you are able. Food donated at church is taken to support our local food bank.

SVP: The weekly meeting of the older men in the parish for lunch and a chat will be at the Applewood Farm at 1.00pm on Wednesdays.

Churches Together in Boothstown: We are looking to re-energise this ecumenical cooperation and invite parishioners to consider supporting this. Events such as a carol service and services for Christian Unity as well as social occasions bring us together in fellowship. An open meeting will be held in Holy Family church (please note changed location as the flooring is being replaced in the hall) on Thursday 19th October at 7.30pm. All welcome.

Slow Cooker Course for Priests

On Wednesday 13 September, 10 priests gathered in the Alba Restaurant, Melling for what might have been a first in the Archdiocese - a cooking course for priests. The course was led by Adam Franklin - chef proprietor of Alba. Adam has worked extensively with Feeding Liverpool to provide nutritious meals on a budget, and had designed an educational day for the priests all about using a slow cooker. It wasn't just valuable cooking skills the priests gained - Fr Philip Inch, who attended the course, observed that "for the priests who came on the course, there was a real experience of fellowship in a very different learning environment. The idea for this course came directly from the work done after our Synod in the Pastoral Plan commitment of area six to be a Church that cares for its priests. Making sure that we eat healthily and within a sensible budget is a vital aspect of the way we care for ourselves and each other."
