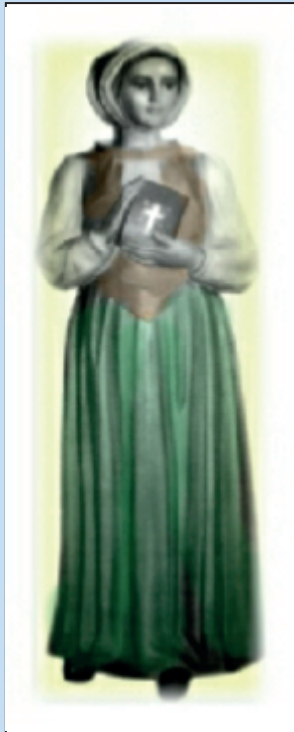

In coming months there will be meetings targeting various ministries such as Eucharistic Ministers and Readers to refresh and grow in the life of our parish.

**Holy Family Tea and Coffee after Mass:** This will begin on Sunday 11th June with tea/coffee and toast in the Parish Hall and will be every other week as we now have enough volunteers to start a rota but more volunteers are needed. If you are willing to go on a rota for serving tea and coffee after Sunday Mass at Holy Family please let Liz know in the office.

**Food Bank:** There is an urgent need for food at the local foodbank. Please donate if you are able. Items can be left in the church porches.

**SVP:** The weekly meeting of the older men in the parish for lunch and a chat will be at the Applewood Farm (**Note new location**) at 1pm on Wednesdays.
