

#### Food for the journey!

In today's first reading we hear the words "Console my people, console them." In the events of this pandemic year, who doesn't long for consolation? As Christians our consolation is in the love and forgiveness of the Lord - and love as we know, always wants to share itself. That's why John the Baptist's life was fuelled by one burning passion – to point others to Jesus. In today's Gospel his cry from the heart calls for life-altering change.
