Public Masses will be on Sunday at 9.00am (earlier time to allow for cleaning before next Mass) and 11.00am and (resuming in early September) on Wednesday at 7.00pm at **Holy Family**.

- To book a place at a Sunday Mass please contact the parish office by phone or email FROM WEDNES-DAY and BY FRIDAY at 2pm with names and numbers coming from each household and a telephone
- To book a place at the Wednesday Mass please contact the parish office FROM TUESDAY and BY WEDNESDAY 2pm. This is hoped to be extended to other days but is dependant on volunteers to steward (aged 70 and under with no health conditions).

Places will be confirmed by either email or phone. Places will be allocated according to distancing and it may not be possible to fit everyone in who applies for places. The archbishop suggests that as the Sunday obligation is not in place people may wish to attend a weekday Mass instead of the Sunday.

Please note that there will be no rosary or Benediction from now until early September.

OTHER ITEMS

Masses will continue as they are until September. Unless there are any changes due to further lockdown restrictions the plan is to reopen St Ambrose Barlow for Mass on Thursday 10th September at 7pm for the feast day of St Ambrose Barlow.

From the weekend of Saturday 12th / Sunday 13th September the Sunday Mass times will be back to normal: Saturday evening 6pm at St Ambrose Barlow,

Sunday 9.30am at Holy Family,

Sunday 11.00am at St Ambrose Barlow.

We are beginning to look at booking baptisms from September. At this time no decision has been made with regards to First Holy Communion celebrations. Fr Paul will be in touch with these families in the near future to look at potential times to safely and suitably celebrate this special time with our children.
