Public Masses and Services may continue in Tier 4 as advertised on the Mass Timetable overleaf. The guidance is the same as before 5th November:

The <u>social distancing</u> rules, <u>wearing of face coverings</u> and <u>using hand sanitisation</u> remain the same. We will continue to book in for each Mass by phone or email to the parish office for track and trace purposes.

- In tier four weddings are not permitted. Funerals which take place in church may only be attended by up to 30 people maximum.
- Baptisms may be attended only by those from one household (Godparents stand by proxy).
 If Baptisms are within public Mass the number is dependant on the safe number as per our risk assessments.
- Communal singing is still not allowed at this time.
- The Sunday Obligation remains suspended by the Bishops Conference.
