Taking to heart the last words of the Lord Jesus, we will go into the world to proclaim the Good News to the whole of creation.

GOSPEL REFLECTION

In today's Gospel, we hear the famous story of Jesus feeding the crowd in the desert. They had come to listen to him speak. Jesus had two good reasons why he might have sent them away. Firstly, Herod, who had already murdered his cousin, John, was expressing an interest in meeting him. So it was surely a time for Jesus to keep a low profile. Secondly, the disciples needed a break, having just returned from a mission. But Jesus didn't send them away. He looked at them with compassion and saw that they were like sheep without a shepherd. So he gathered them around him. Picture Jesus surrounded by over 5000 people. They were drawn by the magnetism of his words and no doubt the warmth of his personality. The first thing he did was to teach them about the Kingdom of Heaven. Then he healed the sick. By the time he finished, it was late afternoon and everyone was hungry. The disciples urged him to send the people away. Instead he worked a great miracle to feed them. The miracle of the multiplication of the loaves and fishes, when the Lord said the blessing and distributed the food to the multitude, prefigured the food he gives us in the Eucharist.

On the day of the resurrection, the early Christians met to break bread. From that time on down to our own day, the celebration of the Eucharist has continued so that today we encounter it everywhere in the Church. It remains the centre of the Church's life. Vatican II described it as the "source and summit" of all that we do as Christians. We are the new people of God. Jesus is in our midst. Here, we hear his voice when the scriptures are proclaimed. They are living words which console, inspire and challenge us today.

Today we continue to be nourished with the Bread of Life. As Jesus says himself, "Unless you eat my flesh and drink my blood you shall not have life in you" (John 6:53). At the end of Mass, we are not simply dismissed, but sent forth as bearers and sharers of God's life with others.

As we celebrate this great feast of the Body and Blood of Christ, we proclaim that Jesus is in our presence. We continue to celebrate his presence until we share in the banquet of his Kingdom, a banquet he chooses to share with all of God's children.
